**The Cherry Harvest for 2016 is well underway!**

**SW MI** - The fruit is of very good quality and color. Fruit size seems quite good. Cherries are processing well. Growers suggesting that they are picking at around 50 - 60% of last year.

**OR** - OR started harvesting while the CIAB meeting was held June 23. There is variation in handlers' status. Some are almost done while others have not yet begun. Quality is excellent and cherries are "gorgeous". May be short of estimate.

**PA** - The harvest in PA went very quickly; they have finished harvest. While total production is small, it is twice the estimate.

**WA** - WA also started just about the time of the CIAB meeting last month. The crop is quite heavy and fruit is of very good quality. Weather and temperatures have been quite good during the harvest.
