Harvest 2007: PA - quality generally good, but somewhat variable; not yet finished with harvest; some rains helped size fruit.

SW MI - quality still quite good; brix levels high; pitting well; some handlers will have a small amount of production in week 3; in-orchard diversions continuing into week 3.

WC MI - fruit is very nice with good color and brix levels; cherries started somewhat small, but recent rains helped size the fruit.

NW MI - harvest has begun here, too; color good; pitting pretty well; brix levels very good.

UT - production just starting up; quality looks good with color and brix.

WA - started harvesting this week; have not received reports on quality of fruit.
