We are very happy to report that, so far, the CIAB's estimates of production have understated the quantity of cherries that are actually being delivered. We hope that this trend continues and that the industry harvests more in line with the Guesstimate's projections than the CIAB's estimates.

None of the 3 districts with reportable production have indicated that they are finished. PA and SW MI will have a bit more to report. WC MI will continue for awhile. There was a trickle of cherries reported from NW MI for week 2. The amount was not significant enough to appear on this report, but it indicates that harvest throughout MI is compressed.

Reports from both NY and WI suggest that they, too, are likely to deliver more than estimated. They start soon and are likely to appear on next week's report.
