SW MI - Multiple storms with much wind and rain impacted the harvest. Quantity is down from what had been expected. Some quality concerns due to weather.

WC MI - Harvest started this week. First impressions are that the quality is good. Quantity vs estimate not known yet.

PA - PA is done. Harvested just over ½ of its estimate.

OR - Harvest going well. Temperatures have been very high for OR. Quality is good and the cherries are pitting quite nicely.

WA - Like OR, temps in WA are high. This will impact fruit and harvest.

Other areas - No other districts harvested. NY & UT likely to start in Week 3.
