**Harvest 2007: PA** - Almost finished, but some production for Week 4. Quality was acceptable, but overall size small.

**SW MI** - The harvest is finished. Quality was quite good overall. Production was light. The diversion number represents CIAB's best effort to calculate the diversion including random row activities. Figures may be adjusted with additional information.

**WC MI** - fruit still very nice and pitting well. Should finish with Week 4. Some suggesting that crop will be light of estimate.

**NW MI** - Harvest going in earnest. Quality, color and brix levels very good. Pitting nicely. Some growers suggesting a lighter crop.

**UT** - Quality good. Very hot

**WA** - fruit pretty good. Some picking lighter than expected. Very hot weather that could affect quality.

**WI** - has begun harvesting. Too early to say much.
