OR - Finishing up. Temperatures have been pretty high, but the fruit is very good and pitting well. Should finish in Week 4.

UT - Started harvest in Week 3. Quality quite good.

WA - Harvest continues strongly. Hot, but quality still good.

WI - Not yet harvesting. May start late in Week 4.
