Harvest 2009: Harvest is moving along. Even WI is harvesting.

NW MI - Harvest is getting serious now. Fruit reported to be quite nice. It is pretty early to determine how large the crop will be, but some early results are showing larger than anticipated production from orchards.

WC MI - Fruit quality is very good and has held up. Yields are holding quite well. May not reach est.

SW MI - Harvest is effectively over. Quality good overall.

NY - Quality fair to good. Harvest will probably exceed est.

OR - Cherries are "beautiful". Some high temps. expected

UT - Excellent quality. Crop likely to exceed est.

WA - Quality is okay. Not sure if state will reach est.

WI - Quality very nice. Too early to project volumes.
