NY production is moving steadily forward. It should be completed in week 5. They are significantly over estimate.

UT started in week 4 and is going quite strong. It is very warm out west. The cherries look good, and the quality is also good. Unknown how they will pick versus the estimate.

WA also started in week 4. It is very warm there, too. It is far too early to tell how they will pick versus the estimate.
