NW MI - This was the first big week of harvest. Quality of delivered cherries is very good. Some growers are picking more than anticipated while others are close to estimates.

WC MI - Production dropped off from Wk 3. Quality still very good. Harvest will continue in Wk 5. May be shy of estimate.

NY - Quality of cherries is very good. Has been hot. May pick short of estimate by a little bit.

OR - Harvest continues. Quality still good.

UT - Fully into harvest now. It has been quite hot during harvest, but quality is holding up. Expect to reach estimate.

WA - Harvest complete, but some adjustments possible. Quality was very good. Temps during harvest cooler than normal.

WI - Picking in earnest starting Wk 4. Good quality.
