Congratulations on the finish of another cherry harvest!

The overall harvest was 13% smaller than estimated on a national basis. There was, however, quite a bit of variance between districts and states. Mid-Western states tended to be below estimate while the Western States all produced substantially above their estimates. PA estimated best.

The smaller production figures will cause the restriction percent to go down. How much it will change will depend both upon the production numbers and any adjustments that might be made by the CIAB at its September meeting.

The CIAB meets at the Crowne Plaza, Grand Rapids, MI on 09/15/11 at 9:00 AM to review the OSF in light of the crop and to make any appropriate adjustments to this year's OSF.
